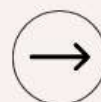

1-MULBERRY IS A DECIDUOUS TREE IN THE FIG FAMILY;

2-MULBERRY FRUITS ARE THE RECORD HOLDERS IN TERMS OF CALCIUM CONTENT. FOR EXAMPLE, TEA FROM THE LEAVES OF THIS PLANT CONTAINS TWENTY-TWO TIMES MORE CALCIUM THAN WHOLE COW'S MILK.

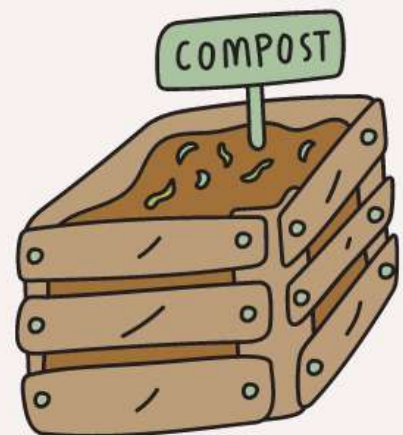
