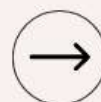

ABOUT ONION

- 1-THE MOST COMMON ONION COLORS ARE YELLOW, RED, AND WHITE;**
- 2-IN THE MIDDLE AGE, ONIONS WERE AN ACCEPTABLE FORM OF CURRENCY, AND WERE USED TO PAY FOR RENT, GOODS AND SERVICES;**
- 3-THE REASON WHY ONIONS MAKE US CRY IS THAT CUTTING INTO IT RELEASES SULFURIC ACID, WHICH REACTS WITH THE MOISTURE IN OUR EYES TO CREATE A TEARFUL REACTION;**
- 4-DYEING FABRIC THE NATURAL WAY WITH ONION SKINS IS A ZERO-WASTE PROCESS AND CUTS DOWN ON FOOD WASTE BY PROVIDING AN ALTERNATIVE USE FOR SKINS. IT'S ALSO A TRADITIONAL CRAFT THAT DATES BACK TO 2600 B.C.;**
- 5-THE LARGEST ONION EVER GROWN WEIGHTED AROUND 5KG.**
